Staff: Janan Lindroos, Executive Director.


Call to Order: President Gary Carvahlo called the meeting to order at 9:58 am.

Review and Approval of Minutes: The March 9, 2026 Board Meeting Minutes were reviewed. Don Snider made a motion to approve the minutes; 2nd by Bob Harshaw.

Review and Approval of Bills: Bills were reviewed. Delphine Rossi made a motion to approve the bills; 2nd by Don Snider.

New Business:

1. Meeting with the Lincoln County Commissioners May 4th at 11:15 am in Afton: Janan stated the Thayne Senior Center has a meeting with the Lincoln County Commissioners to review the Center's Lincoln County FY 2027 budget on May 4th in Afton. Board members are welcome to attend. We will leave the Center at 10:30 am for the meeting.
2. Town of Alpine invoice for Alpine Meals \$5,280.00 for 1056 meals: Janan noted she sent an invoice to the town of Alpine for Tuesday senior meals and we do not have to meet with the mayor and town council this year to review the invoice/meal program.
3. Summer Delivery Routes: Gary discussed possible meal delivery route changes if there are more summer people requesting meals, especially in the SVRV Park. Janan noted she will make changes to the meal delivery routes as necessary for the summer. Bob asked if more drivers were needed for the summer and Janan said she is not sure at this time which of the summer volunteers will be driving for the Center.
4. Prizes and Booth for Mountain Main Days on June 26-28: There was a discussion on the upcoming Mountain Man Days event. The booth is set and Jymme Snider is compiling a list of volunteers for the booth. Gary inquired about the raffle prizes and both the rafting certificate and gun are all set. Janan will make signs for both raffle prizes. Gary will register the gun with The Gunslinger in Alpine. Don will inquire at



Broulim's Alpine for a donation of water. We discussed selling raffle tickets at the Center the week before the event and decided to do so beginning the week of June 15-19. Raffle tickets will be \$10.00 for 1 ticket or 6 tickets for \$50.00.

5. 2026 Golf Tournament: A discussion was held on the upcoming August 14th golf tournament. Janan noted she has not received a contract for the tournament. Gary said he would check with the golf shop/pro Nick Harding, and find out about an invoice. Janan said she has the signs for the sponsors.
6. Updated golf sponsor list: We reviewed the updated golf sponsor list and Gary took time to review and make additional changes to the list. Gary noted he still has not received an updated business list from the Star Valley Chamber of Commerce. Various new businesses were discussed and several were added to the list. We discussed strategies when meeting with potential sponsors and how to gather support from local businesses. It was noted to mention to potential hole sponsors that we will put their business banner on the course or by the clubhouse for marketing purposes.
7. Golf Gift Bags: Janan noted she will meet with the Bank of Star Valley and confirm the gift bags (100). Janan will spend about \$1,000.00 on gift bag supplies at Costco and Sam's Club. Steve noted a Jackson Beverage Distributor is donating 100 can cozies and possibly other items. The menu of the day, breakfast and lunch, has not been decided.
8. Fundraisers: Murder Mystery Dinner – Janan noted the SVHS drama director has not returned her calls and so the mystery dinner is on hold.

- Janan noted the Dinner Club in May will be the last dinner club until the fall.

Senator Dockstader will discuss the recent Wyoming Legislative Session and its implications for Wyoming and Lincoln County as well as update the participants on what's happening overall in Lincoln County.
- Janan shared the new kitchen cook, Lanae, will begin May 1st.
- Janan made copies of the golf tournament sponsor packets for board members to distribute.
