THREE INGREDIENT HOMEMADE ICE CREAM



Ingredients

2 cups Heavey Cream

1 (14oz) can Sweetened Condensed Milk

1 tsp Vanilla Extract

Mix in items of your choice, Chocolate, Crushed Oreos, Caramel, Finely Choppped Strawberries (any fruit), sprinkles, etc.

Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, whip the cream until stiff peaks form.
 - *You can use an electric beater to make this process easier.*
- 2. Add chilled and sweetened condensed milk and vanilla; stir slowly until just combined.
- 3. Stir in mix-ins of your choice. Get creative! You can separate your base into multiple containers to try more flavors.
- 4. Seal into Tupperware containers with lids, and freeze at least 4 hours before enjoying.
